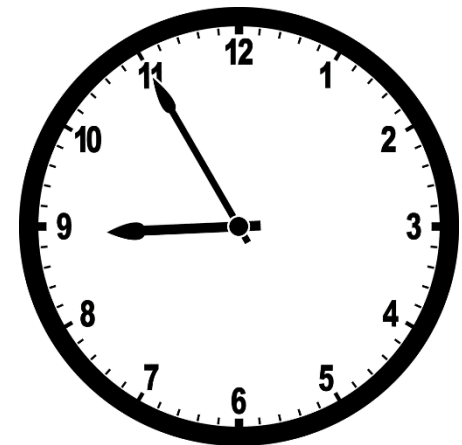
Absences
