

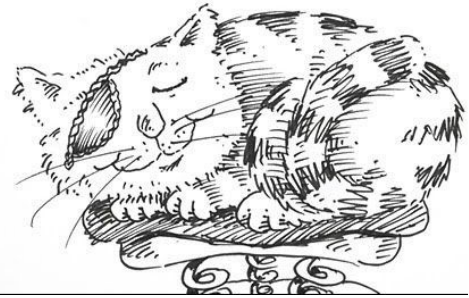
# Greenlands Year 2
